- If the kettle is overfilled, boiling water may be ejected.

BEFORE THE FIRST USE

- Take the appliance and accessories out the box. Remove the stickers, protective foil or plastic from the device.
- Place the device on a flat stable surface and ensure a minimum of 10 cm. free space around the device. This device is not suitable for installation in a cabinet or for outside use.
- The kettle has a dual voltage selector on the underside of the kettle. Always check that the correct voltage is selected before using the
- Before the first use boil a full kettle of water to clean the kettle and discard this water

- Set the voltage selector into the position corresponding to the supply
- Open the lid by pressing the button "OPEN".
 Fill the kettle with water to the "MAX" level mark. The water level must not exceed the "MAX" mark.
- If insufficient water is used, the kettle will switch off, with too much water it may boil over.
- · Check if the lid is properly closed.
- Plug in and press switch to ON position.
 The kettle will boil and switch off automatically.
- To interrupt the boiling process, press the switch to OFF position. If the appliance is accidentally switched on when empty, the boil-dry protection will automatically switch it off. Adding cool water will cool the boil-dry protection mechanism which enables you to use the kettle

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

- Before cleaning, unplug the appliance and wait for the appliance to
- Use a soft damp cloth to clean the housing of the device.
 Clean the appliance with a damp cloth. Never use harsh and abrasive
- cleaners, scouring pad or steel wool, which damages the device. Never immerse the device in water or any other liquid. The device is not dishwasher proof.
- The device should be regularly decalcified. Use a descaling product
- which is suitable for household appliances.

 Rinse the kettle several times with clean water after descaling.
